Meet Conditions

GENERAL

1. The meet will be held under ASA Laws & Regulations and ASA Technical Rules of Racing and has been licensed at Level 3 by the ASA for entry into County and Regional Competitions.
2. All competitors must be British Swimming Registered and must be Category 2 members of a club affiliated to the ASA, WASA or SASA.
3. In extenuating circumstances, and due to situations out of the clubs control during the meet, the Referee has the right to make changes to the conditions on the day in order to ensure the smooth running of the meet.
4. Age groups for the meet are based on age as at **27th November 2016**.
5. Swimmer's entry information will be held on a computer solely for the purposes of administering the meet. By submitting an entry, consent is deemed to have been given, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet upon request, and details may be made public before, during, or after the meet for the purposes of running the meet and publishing results.
6. In accordance with recommendations of the ASA child protection policy, any person wishing to use video, zoom or close range photography, including mobile phones that have photographic capabilities should first register their details at the spectator entrance. It is requested that all mobile phones are switched off or to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each race.
7. Clubs are requested to **provide one licenced official / time keeper for every 8 swimmers entered**. Names and contact details will be requested once a club's entry has been received. The meet promoter will endeavour to ensure sufficient officials / timekeepers to meet the license requirements for each session. If this proves not to be possible for a session, times from that session will not be submitted to the ASA rankings. Please complete the Officials Reply Slip and forward to officials@soundwellswim.org.uk
8. All results will be sent by email at the end of the Competition.
9. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither the Promoter, Soundwell Swimming Club nor GL1 Leisure Centre will accept responsibility for any property that may be lost, stolen or damaged.
10. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any spectator, competitor or coach.
11. All meet competitors and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at GL1 Leisure Centre and follow any instructions given by Leisure Centre Staff.
12. For the duration of the meet, Team Managers and Coaches will be responsible for the conduct of their swimmers. It is therefore expected that Team Managers and Coaches will supervise their swimmers at all times.
13. Swimmers seating and spectator areas, although situated in the same block, are separated by dividing ropes. **Under no Circumstances (except when using as an evacuation route) should swimmers or spectators cross these dividing ropes. Additionally neither spectators nor swimmers are allowed to sit on the access steps to these areas. This is a Health & Safety requirement of the Leisure Centre that we are**

obliged to enforce. Entry to the swimmers' area is through the changing village and onto poolside. Entry to the spectators' seating area is from the first floor.

14. No-one will be permitted poolside or swimming/spectator seating area until the Promoters and/or Meet Referee permit it. Only members of the ASA (or equivalent national body), leisure centre staff, and appointed timing staff are permitted poolside.
15. Any swimmer or club breaking these conditions will be liable to disqualification from any or all events.
16. The competition pool is an 8-lane, deck-level, 25m pool with a water depth of 2m throughout. Anti-turbulence lane ropes (including at the sides) will be used and turning flags will be placed at both ends of the pool.
17. Hy-Tek/Omega electronic placing and timing will be used. Speakers are situated in the blocks on all lanes (Rule FR 4.3.3). It should be noted that timing pads are only situated at the finishing end of the pool. The operation of the electronic timing will be in accordance with Rule SW 13. Please note that the scoreboard is only an indication of placing/times and the final results will be at the referee's discretion
18. All events will be run on a Heat Declared Winner ("HDW") basis. Entries will be seeded into heats from submitted times, with the slowest heat first and all heats spearheaded. Short Course Entry Times should be submitted.
19. All starts where possible and where agreed with the Referee will be over the top.
20. Medals will be given to the top 3 swimmers in the age groups. The age groups for the meet are 9/10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16/Over. **Any swimmer who swims faster than the Upper Qualifying Time (UQT) in a particular event will not be eligible for a medal in that event. Speeding Tickets will be issued during this meet.**
21. All swimmers must report to the Competition Stewards when instructed to do so. Any competitor not reporting on time may be excluded.
22. **Swimmers will be required to sign in for 400m events only. Swimmers must sign in to confirm that they are swimming in these events prior to the start of warm up for the session in which the relevant event takes place. Failure to sign will result in the swimmer being removed from the event and their entry fee for that event being forfeited.**
23. All swimmers must be able to execute a competitive racing dive as laid down in ASA law or they should start in the water. It is the swimmer's, or their representative's, responsibility to inform a meet official of any reason why they cannot conform to ASA technical rules; this should be done before the event in which they are taking part commences. No swimmer should topple into the water in the event of a false or faulty start, a proper shallow dive must be performed.
24. The referee's decision is final.
25. Any situation not covered by the above conditions will either be referred to the Meet Referee for a decision on technical issues or to the Promoter. The outcome of any decision will be based on ASA Law or Technical Rules or in the spirit of fairness and equity and will be announced accordingly.
26. Should it be necessary to cancel the meet, for reasons beyond the control of the promoter, refunds will be at the promoters discretion.

ENTRIES

27. All club entries must be made using the Hy-Tek software only and submitted, along with an Entry Summary sheet, via e-mail. Individual entries may be made using the official meet Entry Form and submitted, along with an Entry Summary sheet, via e-mail.
28. All payment should be made by cheque, made payable to 'Soundwell Swimming Club', and forwarded to the address specified along with hard copy of the Entry Summary and Entry Form (where an individual entry). For all club entries, payment should be made via a single cheque, no cash will be accepted. When posting, please use first class mail, DO NOT send by recorded delivery as this can delay it reaching the promoter if no one is available to sign for it.
29. For all entries please supply an email address or an A4 SAE to enable us to return your acceptance/rejections and any other information as required.
30. The meet file will be available to download from the Soundwell Swimming Club website www.soundwellswim.org.uk or can be obtained by contacting competition@soundwellswim.org.uk
31. Entries received without payment will not be processed.
32. **The entry fee is £6 per event. All competitors will be limited to a maximum of 10 events.**
33. **Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis and must reach the Meet Promoter by midnight on Monday 17th October 2016.** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Promoter, but not to the detriment of entries already received. The meet may also close to entries at an earlier date if capacity is reached.
34. **Should the number of entries received for the meet becomes untenable, the promoter reserve the right to limit the time of individual events to 30 minutes in order to ensure the efficient running of the meet.** In this scenario events will be targeted in descending distance order, starting with 400m events, in order to limit the number of rejected entries. The principle of first come, first served will be adhered to at event level.
35. **Coach/Team Manager passes for the whole or part of the meet will be £15.00 per person,** to include a programme, collected on the day at the inquiry desk. Passes are restricted to a maximum of 4 per Club. It is the responsibility of the attending clubs to ensure that all Coaches/Chaperones have an up to date CRB and wear their passes at all times when on poolside.
36. All events will be swum in combined age groups seeded on entry times. Submitted entries must be in accordance with the attached upper limit schedule. **It is the responsibility of all swimmers/parents and coaches to enter correct times.**
37. Entries will be confirmed by e-mail only. It is the responsibility of the club entering the competitors to check for any inaccuracies in the confirmed entries. **Any inaccuracies must be notified to the Meet Promoter prior to the Meet.**
38. The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry. Incorrect or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Entries are accepted on the basis the competitor accepts the Promoters Conditions.
39. No refunds will be made to competitors who withdraw after advice of acceptance unless in extenuating circumstances and at the discretion of the promoter.

40. Acceptance / rejection of entries will be confirmed as soon as possible following the closing date for entries. All refunds will be made to the club submitting the entries as will be arranged with each club as appropriate.
